The role will require developing an in-depth knowledge of NPDES permit compliance, safety, public entity procurement policies and procedures, operating and maintaining a Membrane BioReactor plant, operating and maintaining equipment, SCADA operations, collection system maintenance, and biosolids processing and handling.
